Hello RoseWood Village Residents, Families, and Team members,

I wanted to give everyone an update on RoseWood Village and the status related to COVID restrictions/precautions. New guidance from the CDC addresses the COVID Delta Variant and updates our current guidelines regarding personal protective equipment, including masks. The CDC recommends all visitors, regardless of vaccination status, to wear a face covering while in any common area in the facility. If your loved one is fully vaccinated and you are fully vaccinated, you may remove your face mask while in your loved one's apartment. Otherwise, we ask that you always wear a mask within the facility and follow our screening process during check in and check out. We will be strongly encouraging our residents, regardless of vaccination status, to wear their masks in all common areas.

We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we continue to work with these new guidelines from the CDC. No vaccine is 100% effective and viruses are constantly mutating. We will keep you updated with any changes as we receive them. Please know that we are available to answer any questions. Please be sure to stay informed by checking our webpage for updates.
