In response to the results of our COVID 19 testing, performed on September 9th, 2021, the Virginia Department of Health recommended that RoseWood Village at Greenbrier have 2 weeks of consecutive retesting of all residents and staff to determine or confirm that there are no additional positive cases prior to resuming our reopening plan.
