Greetings Residents, Families and Team Members,

At RoseWood Village, our primary concern is the health and safety of our residents, families, and team members. We wish to keep our community informed about the evolving Covid-19 status in our building. On January 15, 2022, one of our residents tested positive for Covid-19. As a result, the resident was immediately placed on quarantine and is being assisted pertaining to protocol, including family notification. Also, as a result, we tested other residents who may have been exposed and are pleased to report that their Covid-19 test results were negative. This event is classified as a Covid-19 exposure, not an outbreak.

Our community has prepared for this type of situation and is taking the following immediate actions:

- We are in the process of informing the Virginia Department of Health of the positive case.
- We will continue testing residents if and/or when necessary.
- We are encouraging residents to wear masks when they move around the community.
- We will continue communal dining and activities unless there is another incident.

Again, we share this information with you not to alarm you, but to keep you as informed as possible. Currently, we ask for your patience as we work through this situation. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. Please know that we are always here to support our families and team members. Do not hesitate to give me a call if you have any questions or comments.
