Greetings Residents, Families and Team Members,

In keeping with our promise to keep our Rosewood Greenbrier family informed about the evolving Covid-19 status in our community, here is the update from the last testing completed on 3/1/22. There were no positive cases detected! As a result of Tuesday's testing, the two residents who tested positive on 2/22/22, will remain on isolation until Friday, March 4, 2022. For that cause, the community remains still on an "outbreak" status, as specified by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and our community's protocol. The "outbreak" status ceases on March 22, 2022, if there are no new cases of two or more residents or team members.

Rosewood Village Greenbrier will resume the mitigation set forth by the CDC and our community's protocol attempting to avoid any new cases while still being in this "outbreak" status. Moving forward, we will only test if a resident or team member has symptoms. We do however, mandate that any family member visiting the residents who are positive, utilize the personal protective equipment that we have prepared for you. For those residents who are not positive, there remains no change to visitation.

As noted from the previous letter, our facility has prepared for this type of situation and is taking the following immediate actions:

- We have made the Virginia Department of Health aware of the negative cases and confirmed the immediate steps that are concurrent with our policies and procedures which we drafted from the CDC.
- We are continuing to be vigilant and test residents and team members as necessary pending any symptoms.
- We are encouraging residents to wear masks when they move around the community.
- Communal dining is open.
- Our beauty shop is now open.

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- Our group activities have resumed. Residents are encouraged to continue wearing masks and use hand sanitizer before and after the activity. The activity team members will sanitize the areas utilized after each activity.

Again, we share this information with you not to alarm you, but to keep you as informed as possible. We are pleased that everyone has adhered to our requests and is making this most inconvenient situation more bearable. Currently, we ask for your continued patience as we work through this situation. Thank you for your cooperation. Please know that we are always here to support our families and team members. Do not hesitate to give me a call if you have any questions.
